The motions for leave to file an amicus brief filed by Norman S. Primus, the University Professors, and Ellen Richards are granted.


The motion for leave to supplement the record filed by the GI Forum is granted.

The motion to enlarge the page limit and the time to file responsive brief, filed by the State of Texas, is granted.


Oral argument will be held in **Dallas, Texas**, at the United States Courthouse, 1100 Commerce Street, Courtroom 1546, Dallas, Texas, on **January 21, 2005**, beginning at 9:00 a.m. All briefs are to be filed no later than January 14, 2005. In its briefing, the State is to respond not only to the plaintiffs' briefs, but also to the amicus brief filed by the University Professors.

Plaintiffs are allowed 90 minutes for argument, to be allocated between opening and rebuttal, and among the parties, at plaintiffs' discretion, as long as one of the University Professors is allowed to participate in the argument. The State is allowed 90 minutes for its argument.
