

Dear Counsel,

Per U.S. Supreme Court Rule 37.2(a), we are writing to notify you of the intent of Lawyers Democracy Fund, a 501(c)(4) non profit organization, to file an *amicus curiae* brief in support of the respondents in *William Crawford, et al. v. Marion County Election Board, et al.* and *Indiana Democratic Party, et al. v. Todd Rokita, et al.* docket nos. 7-21 and 7-25.

The issues sought to be raised in this brief are: 1) the petitioners lack the requisite Article III standing to bring the suit; 2) if standing is found, the Court should find the Indiana Voter Identification law is non-discriminatory and does not impose a severe burden upon the right to vote, under the standard set forth in *Burdick v. Takushi*, 504 U.S. 428 (1992); and 3) insufficient empirical evidence exists to support the conclusion that photo identification requirements for voting discriminate against minorities, the poor, and the elderly.
