Professor Hasen is the Chancellor's Professor of Law and Political Science at UC Irvine. Prior to his appointment in 2011, he served as the William H. Hannon Distinguished Professor of Law at Loyola Law School in Los Angeles. Professor Hasen is a nationally recognized authority on election law and campaign finance regulation, including constitutional issues involving First Amendment, due process, and equal protection. He has taught courses in a variety of areas including Remedies, Election Law/Law of the Political Process Seminar, Torts, Legislation and Contracts. Professor Hasen is co-author of a leading casebook on election law and from 2001-10 he served as founding co-editor of the quarterly peer-reviewed publication, Election Law Journal. Hasen also writes the widely read [Election Law Blog](#). In 2013, Professor Hasen was named one of the **100 most influential lawyers in America** by *The National Law Journal*. He is the author of *The Voting Wars: From Florida 2000 to the Next Election Meltdown* (Yale University Press, 2012)
