
ORDERED:

1. Relators' emergency motion for temporary relief, filed in case no. 20-0847 October 23, 2020, is granted. The mandate and judgment dated October 23, 2020, in Cause No. 03-20-00498-CV, styled *Greg Abbott, in his Official Capacity as the Governor of Texas; and Ruth Hughs, in her Official Capacity as Texas Secretary of State v. The Anti-Defamation League Austin, Southwest, and Texoma Regions; Common Cause Texas; and Robert Knetsch*, in the Third Court of Appeals, Travis County, Texas, are stayed. The temporary injunction issued by the district court is not in effect pending further order of this Court.

2. The real parties in interest are requested to respond to relators' petition for writ of mandamus on or before **5:00 p.m., October 26, 2020**.

3. The petition for writ of mandamus remains pending before this Court.
